

Comfort

Editor's note: For one year after the death of her husband our mother daily sought comfort from the Scriptures. Below she wrote each day the verse which spoke to her:

March 29 (1998), Psalm 46: 10,11. "Be still and know that I am God. I will be exalted among the nations. I will be exalted in the earth. The Lord Almighty is with us; the God of Jacob is our fortress."

March 30, Isaiah 8, 9. "For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither your ways My ways declares the Lord. As the heavens are higher then the earth, so are My ways higher then your ways and My thoughts then your thoughts."

March 31, Hebrews 11: 4. "He died, but through his faith he is still speaking."

April 1, Nehemiah 8: 10, "Do not grieve, for the joy of the Lord will be your strength." (This was the day of Dad's funeral and memorial service in Edmonton.)

April 2, Psalm 71: 14, "But I will hope in Thee continually, and will praise Thee more and more!"

April 3, Psalm 71: 17, 18, "So, even to old age and gray hairs, O God, do not forsake me, until I proclaim Thy might to all generations. Thy power and Thy righteousness O God, reach the heavens!"

April 4, Psalm 73: 24, "Thou does guide me with thy counsel, and afterwards receive me to Glory."

April 5, Malachi 4: 2, "For you, who fear My name, the sun of righteousness shall rise, with healing in its wings. You shall go forth leaping like calves from the stall."

April 6, Malachi 3: 10, "Bring the full tithes in to the storehouse, that there may be food in My house (to do the work in the Church) and there by put Me to the test, says the Lord of host, if I will not open the windows of heaven for you, and pour down for you an overflowing blessing."

April 7, Zechariah 10: 1, "Ask for rain from the Lord in the season of the spring rain, from the Lord who makes the storm clouds, who gives men showers of rain, to every one the vegetation in the field."

April 8, Psalm 75:1, "We give thanks to Thee O God, we give thanks to Thee, we call on Thy name and recount Thy wondrous deeds."

April 9, Habakkuk 3: 17,18, "Though the fig tree does not blossom, nor fruit be on the vines, the produce of the olive fail and the fields yield no food, the flock be cut off from the fold, and there be no herd in the stall, yet I will rejoice in the Lord. I will joy in the God of my salvation."

April 10, " Habakkuk 3: 19, "God, the Lord, is my strength; He makes my feet like hinds feet, he makes me tread upon my high places."

April 11, Hymn 349, New Church Hymnal.

“Precious Lord, take my hand, lead me on, help me stand; I am tired, I am weak, I am worn. Through the storm, through the night. Lead me on to the Light. Take my hand precious Lord, lead me Home.”

April 12, Hosea 6: 3, “Let us know, let us press to know the Lord, His going forth is as sure as the dawn. He will come to us as the showers of the spring rains that water the earth.”

April 13, Psalm 42: 5, 6, “Why are you cast down, O my soul, and why are you so disturbed within me? Hope in God for I shall again praise Him, my Savior and my God.”

April 14, Psalm 40: 3, “He put a new song in my mouth, a song of praise to our God. Many will see and fear, and put their trust in Him!”

April 15, Psalm 42: 2, “As a deer longs for a flowing streams, so longs my soul for thee O Lord, my soul thirsts for God, for the living God.”

April 16, Psalm 42:8, “By day the Lord commands His steadfast love, and at night His song is with me, a prayer to the God of my life.”

April 17, Psalm 43: 3,2. “ Oh send out thy light and thy truth; let them lead me, let them bring me to Thy holy hill and thy dwelling! Then I will go to the alter of God, the God of my exceeding joy, and I will praise thee with the lyre O God, my God. For thou art the God in whom I take refuge!”

April 18, Psalm 68: 18,19, “Blessed be the God, who daily bears us up; God is our salvation, our God is a God of salvation. Ascribe power to God, whose Majesty is over Israel, and His power is in the skies.”

April 19, John 1:12, “But to all who believed in His name, He gave power to become children of God.”

April 20, John 1: 14, “And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, full of grace and truth; We have beheld His glory, as of the only Son of the Father.”

April 21, John 1:16, “And from His fullness we have all received, grace upon grace, for the law was given through Moses, grace and truth came through Jesus Christ.”

April 22, Taken from Psalm 23. “The Lord will always be your Shepherd. He will not let you Want for anything. He will renew your soul and direct your path. Even when you walk through dark days, you can rest in the knowledge that He will be with you. His goodness and His mercy be there always!”

April 23, Psalm 3: 4,5, “I cry aloud to the Lord, and He answered me from His holy hill. I lie down and sleep; I wake again, for the Lord sustains me!”

April 24, Psalm 5: 7, “But I, by thy great mercy, through the abundance of thy steadfast love, I will enter thy house and I will worship in thy holy temple. Lead me O Lord, in thy righteousness.”

April 25, Psalm 7: 10, 17. “My shield is in God, who saves the upright in heart. God is a right Judge, I will give to the Lord the thanks due to his righteousness, and I will sing praise to the

Name of the Lord, the Most High.”

April 26, Psalm 12: 6, “The promises of the Lord are promises that are pure, silver refined in a furnace on the ground, purified seven times.”

April 27, Isaiah 43, 1-3, “Fear not, I have redeemed you. When you pass through deep waters, I will be with you, for I am the Lord your God.”

April 28, “though clouds of deepest sorrow surround your world today, strength to bear your burden is just a prayer away. Trust in the Masters promise, His love will surely bless; and He will not forsake you, nor leave you comfortless. “(Jack and Ruth Moerman, Blenheim Ont.)

April 29, 2 Corinthians 1: 3, “Blessed be God, the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of all mercies, and the God of all comfort.”

April 30, Psalm 50: 14, “Offer to God a sacrifice of thanksgiving, and pay your vows to the Most High; and call upon Me in the day of trouble; I will deliver you, and you shall glorify Me.”

May 1, Isaiah 54:10, “My steadfast love shall not depart from you, and my covenant of peace shall not be removed, says the Lord, who has compassion on you.”

May 2, Psalm 55: 6,7, “Seek the Lord while he may be found, call upon him while he is near; let the wicked forsake his way, and the unrighteous man his thoughts; let him return to the Lord, that he may have mercy on him, and to our God, for he will abundantly pardon.”

May 3, Psalm 55: 11-12, “So shall My word be that shall go forth from my mouth; it shall not return to me empty, but it shall accomplish that which I purpose, and prosper in the thing for which I sent it. For you shall go out in joy, and be led forth in peace; the mountains and the hills shall break forth in singing, and all the trees of the field shall clap their hands.”

May 4, “The testimony for Christ that your loved one has left behind, will continue to reach out as a blessing to many other lives, just like it has been to ours.” (Marlowe and Karen, Surrey, BC.)

May 5, Deut. 33: 27, “The Eternal God is my Refuge, and underneath are His everlasting arms.”

May 6, “May you find assurance in His Word, Strength in his presence, Comfort in His mercy, and Peace in His Love. Psalm 29: 11 says, “The Lord will give strength to his people.”

May 7, “O, the deep, deep Love of Jesus, Vast, unmeasured, boundless, Free! Rolling as a mighty Ocean in its fullness over me. Underneath me, All around me, is the current of thy love, Leading Onward, leading Homeward, to my glorious Home Above.”

May 8, Psalm 58: 13, “If you turn back your foot from the Sabbath, from doing your pleasure on My holy day, and call the Sabbath a delight, and the holy day of the Lord honorable; if you honor it, not going your own way, or seeking your own pleasure, or talking idly; then you shall take delight in the Lord.”

May 9, Psalm 59: 1,2, “Behold, the Lord’s hand is not shortened, that it cannot save, or His ear dull, that it cannot hear; but your iniquities has made a separation between you and your God, And your sins have hid His face from you, so that He does not hear.”

May 10, Isaiah 51: 12, “I, even I, am He that comforts you.” “Night falls, but day dawns to replace it. Grief comes, but time will ease the pain. Life ends, but death cannot erase it. In memory, Love always will remain.”

May 11, “There are days in our lives that seems darker than any day or (night) we have ever walked through. There are pains in our hearts deepest corners, bringing burdens we never knew. But Jesus has given His promise, and for us who are His, it is true.” “Cast your heavy sorrow upon Him, because He knows and He cares for you!”

May 12, Psalm 27: 1, “The Lord is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear? The Lord is the stronghold of my life, of whom shall I be afraid? Verse 11, 14. Teach me thy way, O Lord; and lead me on a level path. Wait for the Lord; be strong, and let your heart take courage; yes, wait for the Lord!”

May 13, “Love the Lord, all you saints! The Lord preserves the faithful, but abundantly requites him who acts haughtily. Be strong, and let your heart take courage, all you who wait for the Lord!”

May 14, John 11: 25-27, “Jesus said to her: I am the resurrection and the life, he who believes in Me, though he dies, yet shall he live, and whoever lives and believes shall never die. Do you believe this? Yes Lord, I believe that you are the Christ, the Son of God, He who is coming into the world.”

May 15, Psalm 32:1, “Blessed is he whose transgression is forgiven, whose sin is covered. Blessed is the man (and woman) in whose spirit there is no deceit.”

May 16, Psalm 3: 3-5, “But thou, O Lord, art a shield about me, my glory, and the lifter of my head. I cry aloud to the Lord, and He answers me from His holy hill. I lie down and sleep; I wake again, for the Lord sustains me.”

May 17, Psalm 5: 1, “Give ear to my words, O Lord; give heed to my groaning. Listen to the sound of my cry, my King and my God, for to thee do I pray. O Lord, in the morning thou does hear my voice; in the morning I prepare a sacrifice for thee, and watch. (wait).”

May 18, “Lord, you said that once I decided to follow you, You’ll walk with me all the way. But I have noticed that during time of trouble, there is only one set of footprints; I don’t understand why you left me when I needed you the most. The Lord answered: My precious child, I love you and I would never leave you, during your time of trial. When you see only one set of footprints, that’s when I AM carrying you.”

May 19, Ps. 4: 7,8, “Thou has put more joy in my heart than they have, when grain and wine abound. In peace I will both lie down and sleep; for thou alone O Lord, make me dwell in safety.”

May 20, Psalm 32: 7, 8, “Thou art a hiding place for me, thou preserves me from trouble and surrounds me with deliverance. I will instruct you and teach you the way you should go; I will counsel you with My eye upon you.”

May 21, Psalm 33:18, “Behold, the eye of the Lord is on those who fear him, on those who hope in His steadfast love, that He may deliver their soul from death, and keep them alive in famine.”

May 22, Psalm 33: 20-22, “Our soul waits for the Lord; He is our help and shield. Yes, our heart

is glad in Him, because we trust in his holy name. Let thy love, O Lord be upon us.”

May 23, Psalm 34: 1-3. “I will bless the Lord at all times; his praise shall continually be in my mouth. My soul makes its boast in the Lord, let the afflicted hear and be glad. O, magnify the Lord with me, and let us exalt His name together.”

May 24, Psalm 34: 7, “The angel of the Lord encamps around those who fear Him, and delivers them. O taste and see that the Lord is good!”

May 25, Psalm 34: 15-18, “The eyes of the Lord are toward the righteous and his ears toward their cry. When the righteous cry for help. The Lord hears and delivers them out of all their troubles. The Lord is near the broken hearted, and saves the crushed in spirit.”

May 26, Psalm 36: 7-9, “How precious is thy steadfast love O God, The children of men take refuge in the shadow of thy wings. They feast on the abundance of thy house, and thou gives them drink from the river of thy delights. For with thee is the fountain of life; in thy light do we see Light.”

May 27, 1 Peter 1: 3-5, “By his great mercy, we have been born anew to a living hope, through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead. Unto the inheritance which is imperishable, undefiled and unfading, kept in Heaven for you.”

May 28, “Who by God’s power are guarded through faith for a salvation ready to be revealed in the last time. In this we rejoice, though for a little while you may have to suffer various trials, so that the genuineness of your faith, more precious than gold which though perishable, is tested by fire, may bring praise, glory and honor at the revelation of Jesus Christ.”

May 29, 2 Cor. 1: 3,4, “Blessed be God the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of mercies and God of all comfort. Who comforts us in all our affliction, with the comfort with which we ourselves are comforted by God.”

May 30, 2 Corinthians 1: 5, 6, “For as we share abundantly in Christ’s suffering, so through Christ we share abundantly in comfort as well. If we are afflicted, it is for your comfort and Salvation, and if we are comforted, it is for your comfort.”

May 31, Psalm 116: 12,13,15, “What shall I render to the Lord for all His goodness? I will lift up the cup of my salvation and call on the name of the Lord. Precious in the sight of the Lord is the death of his saints.”

June 1, Titus 3: 4-6, “When the kindness and love of God our Savior appeared, he saved us, not of righteous deeds we had done, but because of His mercy. He saved us by the washing of rebirth and renewal by the Holy Spirit, whom he poured out on us generously, through Jesus Christ.”

June 2, Roman 8: 26, 27, “Likewise the Spirit helps us in our weakness, for we do not know how we ought to pray, but the Spirit himself intercedes for us, with sighs too deep for words, and He who searches the hearts of men knows what is in the mind of the Spirit, because the Spirit intercedes according to the will of God.” (When you can’t put your prayer into words, God hears your heart.)

June 3, Deuteronomy 31: 8, “The Lord himself goes before you and will be with you; he will never leave you nor forsake you. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged.”

June 4, When long and steep the path appears, or heavy is the task. Our Father says: “Press on My child, one step is all I ask.”

June 5, Jeremiah 2: 13, “My people have committed two sins: They have forsaken Me, the spring of Living water, and they have dug their own cisterns, broken cisterns, that cannot hold water.” We always have to remember that life gives us unlimited opportunities to store up valuable treasures in heaven, let us never forget the Source of all Life, He made us in His image!

June 6, Someone had said: “I have learned much more from the things I had to do, than from the things I chose to do. Duty can be a delight, if seen as a divine opportunity. It is our Fathers will and precious in His sight, that Christians learn to walk, in wisdom, love and light.”

June 7, John 14:12, “I tell you the truth, anyone who has faith in Me, will do what I have been doing. He will do even greater things than these, because I am going to the Father.” Dad wrote in his Bible: “The Father stands ready to do greater things through us than He did through His Son Jesus Christ. Just Believe that He has given that ability!”

June 8, John 14: 21, “Whoever has my commands and obeys them, he is the one who loves me. He who loves me will be loved by the Father, and I too will love him and show myself to him.”

June 9, Deut.32: 29, “They are a nation without sense, there is no discernment in them. If only they were wise and understand this, and discern what their end will be.”

June 10, “O Lord, You’d have us ponder this truth You would have us see, It’s in this life we chart our course for all Eternity.”

June 11, God’s mercy and ours, Luke 6: 27-31. “God’s perfect standard of loving others.” “It is better to give others a piece of your heart (or more,) than a piece of your mind!”

June 12, 2 Samuel 22: 33, “God is my strength and power, and He makes my way perfect.”

“You may not be the greatest or the strongest. Your presence may not count at all. But when you put your trust in Jesus’ power, He never will let you fall.”

June 13, Luke 24: 50- to 24: 12, “Our own sorrows that seem so final have been changed forever by Jesus’ grave and tomb. It shouts of the Victory He won over sin and death and gives us a living Hope in Him!”

June 14, “May the love of God, family and friends sustain you during this difficult time. We will keep you in our prayers.” Mike and Chris Grant, (Carol’s sister and brother in law. USA)

June 15, The empty cross and the empty tomb provide full salvation. “In the cross of Christ I Glory, towering o’er the wrecks of time. All the light of sacred story, gathers round His head sublime. Bane and blessing, pain and pleasure, By the cross are sanctified; Peace is there that knows no measure, Joys that through all times abide.” HYMN: In the Cross of Christ I glory.

June 16, Proverbs 18: 24, “There is a friend that sticks closer than a brother.”

“The kindest friend I’ve ever had, is One I cannot see. Yet One in whom I can confide,
Who loves and blesses me.”

June 17, John 15: 14, Jesus said: “Greater love has no man than this, that a man lay down his life for his friends. You are my friends, if you do what I command you.”

June 18, Psalm 103:12, “So great is his steadfast love toward those who fear him, as far as the east is from the west, so far has He removed our transgressions from us.”
“Forever gone the sins Christ bore, His work is so complete.
They will be remembered never more! I worship at His feet.”

June 19, Psalm 103: 1-5, “Bless the Lord, O my soul, and all that is within me, bless His holy name. Bless the Lord, O my soul, and forget not one of His benefits. Who forgives all your sins, Who heals all your diseases. Who redeems your life from destruction. Who crowns you with His steadfast love and mercy, Who satisfies you with good as long as you live; so that your youth is renewed like the eagle’s!”

June 20, Psalm 103: 8,9, “The Lord is merciful and gracious, slow to anger and abounding in steadfast love. He will not always accuse nor will He keep his anger for ever.”

June 21, Psalm 103: 15,16, “And for man, his days are like grass; he flourishes like a flower of the field; for the wind passes over it , and it is gone, and its place knows it no more.”

June 22, Psalm 103: 17, 18, “But the steadfast love of the Lord is from everlasting to everlasting upon those who fear Him and His righteousness to children’s children, to those who keep his covenant and remember his commandments.”

June 23, Psalm 103: 19, 20, “The Lord has established his throne in the heavens, and his Kingdom rules over all. Bless the Lord, all you angels, you mighty ones who do His word. Listen to the voice of His word.”

June 24, 2 Corinthians 9: 15, “Thanks be to God for His inexpressible Gift.” “Yes, I know Him as My Savior, for my sins are washed away, and I never cease to praise Him for His truth, through an endless day.”

June 25, Genesis 5: 22, “All the days of Enoch were three hundred and sixty five years. Enoch walked with God; and he was not, for God took him.” “Let me walk with thee dear Savior; side by side and hand in hand. Keep me clean and pure and faithful, until I reach my Heavenly Land.”

June 26, Jeremiah 33: 2,3 “Thus says the Lord who made the earth, the Lord who formed it to establish it- the Lord is his Name: Call on me and I will answer you, and show you great and mighty things that you do not know.”

June 27, “Not what I have gotten; but have received. Grace has bestowed it since I believed. Boasting excluded, pride I base. I am only a sinner saved by grace.”

July 2, Galatians 2: 20, "I have been crucified with Christ; it is no longer I that live, but Christ Who lives in me and the life now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me."

July 3, Galatians 5:22-24, "The fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self- control; against such there is no law."

July 4, Galatians 5: 25, "If we live by the Spirit, let us also walk by the Spirit. Let us have no self-conceit, no provoking of one another and no envy of one another."

July 5, Luke 24: 31, "Their eyes were opened and they Knew Him." "A girl whose Sunday School Teacher had passed away, dreamed about Heaven. She was introduced to Abraham, Paul and David, but not to Jesus, because she Knew Him already."

July 6, "I shall know Him, I shall know Him, as Redeemed by His side I will stand. I shall know Him, I shall know Him; By the print of the nails in His hand." If we know Jesus in this life, you will know Him in the Life here after.

July 7, Psalm 84" 11, "For the Lord God is a sun and shield; He bestows favor and honor. No good thing does the Lord withhold from those who walk uprightly."

July 8, "Has the dearest in life been torn away? Remember that if you could see from the standpoint of Gods wisdom, and of Eternity, you would be able to dry your tears and praise God for them all. Malachi 4:2, "But for you who fear My name the sun of righteousness shall rise, with healing in its wings."
"Sun of my soul my Savior dear; It is not night when thou art near.
O, may no earth born cloud arise, to hide thee from thy servants eyes."

July 9, Psalm 42:8, "By day He commands His steadfast love; and at night His song is with me, a prayer to the God of my life." "Even though our outward man is perishing, yet the inward man is being renewed day by day!" 2 Corinthians 4: 16.

July 10, Ps. 42:8, "By day the Lord commands His steadfast love and at night His song is with me, a prayer to the God of my life."

July 11, 2 Corinthians 4: 16-18, "Therefore we do not lose heart, for outwardly we are wasting away, yet inwardly we are being renewed day by day. For our light and momentary troubles are achieving for our eternal glory that far outweighs them all. So we fix our eyes not on what is seen, but on what is unseen. For what is seen is temporary, but what is unseen is Eternal."

July 12, Phil. 3: 20, 21. "But our citizenship is in heaven. And we eagerly await a Savior from there, the Lord Jesus Christ, who by the power that enables him to bring everything under His control, will transform our lowly bodies so that they will be like His glorious body."

July 13, Hebrew 10: 23-25, "Let us hold fast the confession of our Hope without wavering, for He who promised is faithful; and let us consider to stir up one another to love and good works, not neglecting to meet together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another, all the more as you see the Day drawing near."

July 14, Is.46: 4, "Even to your old age and gray hairs, I am He, who will sustain you. I have made you, and I will carry you, I will sustain you and I will rescue you."
"Nothing is too small for Him to carry, take your burdens to Jesus.
Nothing is too great, why longer tarry? Take your burdens to Him."

July 15, Philippians 2: 14&15, "Do all things without grumbling or complaining (questioning), that you may be blameless and innocent children of God, without blemish in the midst of a crooked and perverse generation, among whom you shine as lights in the world."

July 16, Colossians 3: 17, "And whatever you do, in word and deed, do everything in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through Him."

Instead of complaining let us always count our blessings and sing; "I will praise Him, I will praise Him! Praise the Lamb for sinners slain; Glory all you people, for His blood can wash away each stain."

July 17, Colossians 3: 4,12, "When Christ, who is our life appears, then you also will appear with Him in glory. Put on then, as God's chosen ones, holy and beloved, compassion, kindness, lowliness, meekness and patience."

July 18, Ps.31: 1,5,7, "In Thee O Lord, do I seek refuge, into Thy hand I commit my spirit; thou has redeemed me O Lord, faithful God, I will rejoice and be glad for thy steadfast love, Thou has seen my affliction."

July 19, Ps. 3: 19,24, "O how abundant is thy goodness, which Thou has laid up for those who fear Thee, Be strong, and let your heart take courage, all who wait for the Lord!"

July 20, Ps. 32: 7, 8, "Thou art a hiding place for me, Thou preserves me from trouble and surrounds me with songs of deliverance. I will instruct you and teach you the way you should go. I will counsel you with My eye upon you."

July 21, Ps. 34: 1, 3, "I will bless the Lord at all times; his praise shall continually be in my mouth, O magnify the Lord with me, and let us exalt his name together!"

July 22, Ps. 34: 7, 8, "The angel of the Lord encamps around those who fear Him, and delivers them. O, taste and see that the Lord is good! Happy is the man who take refuge in Him.

July 22, Ps. 34: 17,18, "When the righteous cry for help, the Lord hears and delivers them out of all their troubles. The Lord is near to the broken hearted and saves the crushed in spirit."

July 23, Ps. 36: 7-9, "How priceless is your unfailing love! Both high and low find refuge in the shadow of your wings. They feast on the abundance of your house; you give them drink from your river of delights. For with you is the fountain of Life, in Your light we see Light."

July 24, Ps. 37: 3-7, "Trust in the Lord and do good so and you will dwell in the land and enjoy security. Take delight in the Lord and he will give you the desires of your heart."

"Commit your way to the Lord; trust in Him and He will act."(this was my Dad and Mom's wedding text, April 29, 1914.) "Be still before the Lord, and wait patiently for Him; do not fret."

July 25, Psalm 38 :15, "I wait for you O Lord; you will answer, O Lord my God, for I said : Let them not gloat or exalt themselves over me when my foot slips." Let us confess our sins, enjoy the peace of knowing our sins are forgiven and then ask for the power of the Holy Spirit to be victorious over those sins.

July 26, Deuteronomy 29: 29, "The secret things belong to the Lord our God, but the things who are revealed belong to us and to our children forever, that we may follow all the words of this law."

July 27, Ps. 39: 4-7, "Lord, let me know my end and what is the measure of my days; let me know how fleeting my life is! (You did already Lord!)

Thou has made my days a few hand breaths, and my lifetime is as nothing in thy side. And now Lord, for what do I wait? My hope is in Thee!"

July 28, Ps. 40: 2, 3, "He drew me up from the desolate pit (of grief) and set my feet upon a Rock, making my steps secure. He put a song in my mouth, a song of praise to our God. Many will see and fear and put their trust in the Lord."

July 29, Ps. 34: 15, "The eyes of the Lord are toward the righteous and his ears toward their cry." There never is a night or day when God won't hear us as we pray. There is no time, there is no place when He'll withhold His love and grace!

Aug. 7, Matt.11: 28-30, Jesus said: “Come to Me, all who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you and learn from me; for I am gentle and lowly in heart and you will find rest for your souls. For My yoke is easy and My burden is light.”

Aug. 8, Colossians 3: 1,2 “Set your heart on things above, where Christ is, seated on the right hand of God. Set your minds on things that are above, not on things that are on earth.”

Aug. 9, Colossians 1: 1,5,6, “We always thank God, the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, when we pray for you, because of the Hope laid up for you in heaven. Of this you have heard before in the word the truth, the gospel which has come to you, as indeed in the whole world it is bearing fruit and growing.”

Aug. 17, John 15:16, “You did not choose me, but I chose you and appointed you that you should go and bear much fruit. And that your fruit should abide; so that whatever you ask the Father in My name, He may give it to you.”

Aug.18, John 15: 26, “But when the Counselor comes, whom I shall send from the Father, even the Spirit of truth, who proceeds from the Father, He will bear witness to me and you also are witnesses.”

Aug.19, John 6:27, “Do not labor for the food which perishes, but for the food that endures to Eternal life, which the Son of Man will give to you; for on Him has God the Father set His seal of approval.”

March 18, Psalm 67: 1,2 “May God be gracious to us and bless us and make His face to shine upon us, that thy way be known upon earth, thy saving power among all nations.”

March 19, Psalm 68: 4,5,6 “Lift up a song to Him who rides the clouds; his name is the Lord, exult before Him! Father of the fatherless and protector of the widows is God in his holy habitation. God gives the desolate a home to dwell in; He leads out the prisoners to prosperity; but the rebellious dwell in a parched land.”

March 20, Psalm 71: 17, 18, 23 “O God, from my youth thou has taught me. So even to old age and gray hair, O God, do not forsake me, until I proclaim thy might to all the generations to come. My lips will shout for joy, when I sing praises to thee; my soul also, which thou has rescued.”

March 21, Psalm 73: 1-3 which was one of my Father’s favorite psalm. It almost sounded like that he had struggled with these first three verses he read. I heard once a conversation from him with his closest friend during milking time; they often spoke about these things. I have never forgotten this, my Dad died from a heart attack at 73 years old. The pastor used this psalm at his funeral, as well as my brother when he spoke. “Truly God is good to the upright, to those who are pure in heart. But as for me, my feet had almost stumbled. I had nearly lost my foothold. For I was envious and arrogant when I saw the prosperity of the wicked.”

March 22, Psalm 73: 23-26, 28 “Yet I am always with thee. Thou hold me by my right hand. Thou guide me with thy counsel, and afterwards thou will take me into glory. Who do I have in heaven, but Thee? And there is nothing upon earth that I desire besides Thee. My flesh and my heart may fail, but God is my strength of my heart and my portion forever. But as for me it is good to be near God; I have made the Lord God my refuge, that I may tell of all thy works.”

March 23, Psalm 84: 1,4,11 “How lovely is thy dwelling place, O Lord Almighty. My soul longs and faints for the courts of the Lord; my heart and flesh sing for joy to the living God. Blessed are those who dwell in thy house, ever singing thy praise. For the Lord God is a sun and shield; he bestows favor and honor. No good thing does the Lord withhold from those who walk uprightly.”

March 24, Psalm 86: 11-13 “Teach me thy way, O Lord my God, that I may walk in thy truth; Unite my heart that I fear thy name. I give thanks to thee O God, with my whole heart and will glorify thy name forever. For great is thy steadfast love toward me; and Thou delivers my soul from Eternal death.”

March 25, Psalm 90: 1,2,10,12,16 “Lord, thou art our dwelling place in all generations. Before the mountains stood forth, or ever had formed the earth and the world, from everlasting to everlasting thou art God. The years of our life are three-score and ten, or even by reason of strength four-score; their span is toil and trouble; they are soon gone and fly away.”

March 26, Psalm 90: 12, 16,17 “So teach us to number our days that we may get a heart of wisdom. Let thy work be manifest to thy servants and thy glorious power to their children. Let the favor of the Lord our God be upon us, establish the work of our hands for us, yes, establish the work of our hands!”

March 27, Psalm 91: 1,2 “He who dwells in the shelter of the Most High, who abides in the shadow of the Almighty, will say to the Lord, My refuge and my fortress; my God in whom I trust.”

March 28, Psalm 91: 11,12, 14-16 “For he will give his angels charge of you to guard you in all your ways. On their hands they will bear you up, lest you dash your foot against a stone. Because he cleaves to Me in love, I will deliver him; I will protect him, because he knows My name. When he calls to Me, I will answer him; I will be with him in trouble, I will rescue and honor him. With long life I will satisfy him and show him My salvation.”

I have finished with some of the many promises of God’s Word. I have found much comfort in writing these parts of the Bible. I pray that every one who uses them will be blessed as well.
